ADVISORY SERVICES IN THE FIELD OF ELECTRICITY - UNITED KINGDOM

In addition to the information on training facilities given in the document presented by the Overseas Development Administration (E/CN.14/EP/INF/08), members of the Symposium may find it helpful to be aware of the facilities offered by the following organizations:-

1. The Council for Technical Education and Training in Overseas Countries (TETCC), which can offer advice on:-

Planning industrial training nationally or by industry Analysing training needs and domestic resources

Coordinating general education, training and retaining

Developing training schemes for technical, operative and clinical staff

Training instructors

Trade testing and phase testing for standard setting in industry Selecting training staff

Identifying UK sources of training and training material.

2. The Overseas Consultancy Service of the Electricity Council, through which the "know-how" of the electricity supply industry in the U.K. on technical, commercial, administrative and training matters can be made available to overseas organisations on a consultancy basis.
