

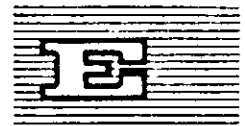

WMO STUDIES ON LOCUST ERADICATION

Resolution 89(V) adopted by the Commission at its
99th Plenary Meeting on 2 March 1963

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Conscious of the need for the increasing application of meteorological science to the aid of economic development of Africa,

Calling the recommendation of WMO's Regional Association for Africa that a regional office of the Organization be established in Africa,

Noting with appreciation the over-increasing technical assistance given by WMO to the continent of Africa, both on a national and a regional plane,

Noting in particular WMO's studies in connexion with the locust eradication campaign, and its intention to hold a study cycle on this subject during the current year;

1. Invites the Executive Secretary to convey to the WMO its support of the proposal for the establishment of a regional office and its desire to see the assistance further expanded,
2. Urges the governments of member States of ECA directly interested in the locust eradication campaign to convey immediately to WMO their requests for the organization of a study cycle on the meteorological aspects of the problem.
