Resolution 38(III) adopted by the Commission at its 53rd plenary meeting on  
17 February 1961.

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Recalling Resolution 8(II)1(a) on intra-African trade and the Conference  
of African Businessmen,

Recognizing the value of continuing contact between African businessmen  
and of explorations by them of means of co-operative action in promoting  
intra-African trade and economic development,

Requests the Executive Secretary to continue to lend his assistance to  
the proposed Conference of African Businessmen to be convened in 1961  
and to any permanent organization which may thereafter be set up and,  
within the resources at his disposal, to provide available information  
of an economic nature and such professional advice and help as he can  
to the Conference and its permanent organization.
