UNITED NATIONS ACCOMMODATIONS IN BANGKOK
AND ADDIS ABABA

1. At its 1933rd plenary meeting held 17 December 1970, the General Assembly adopted resolution 2745(XXV) on United Nations accommodations in Bangkok and Addis Ababa.
2. The text of this resolution is reproduced below and distributed for the information of the Conference.

2745 (XXV) United Nations accommodations in Bangkok
and Addis Ababa

The General Assembly

1. Takes note with appreciation of the reports of the Secretary-General dealing with United Nations accommodations in Bangkok^{1/} and Addis Ababa^{2/}, and of the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions^{3/};
2. Expresses its appreciation of the generous offers of the Governments of the host countries;

3. Concurs in the observations and recommendations of the Advisory Committee^{1/};

4. Authorizes the Secretary-General, bearing in mind those observations and recommendations, to proceed in accordance with the recommendations contained in his reports^{2/};

5. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly annually on the progress made on the construction of these two projects.
