Resolution 156(VIII) adopted by the Commission at its  
139th plenary meeting on 24 February 1967

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Recognizing the vital role of small-scale industries in industrial development,

Recognizing the importance of the contribution of small-scale industries in the training of African entrepreneurs,

Welcomes the establishment of a pilot advisory centre on small-scale industries in Niamey for the West African sub-region,

Recommends that similar centres be established where necessary in other sub-regions.
