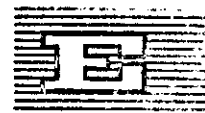

INVITATION TO THE SWISS CONFEDERATION
TO ATTEND THE SESSIONS OF THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION
FOR AFRICA WITH CONSULTATIVE STATUS

Resolution 41(IV) adopted by the Commission at its 58th plenary meeting
on 20 February 1962

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Considering the importance of the role of the Swiss Confederation in the economic development and trade of the African countries and territories;

Recalling its resolution 6 (II) of 27 January 1960;

Having regard to the attitude adopted by the United Nations Economic Social Council in similar cases, as set out in resolutions 617 (XXI) of 20 July 1956, 632 (XXII) of 19 December 1956, and 763 (XXX) of 8 July 1960;

Requests the Economic and Social Council to authorize the Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Africa to empower the Swiss Confederation to attend the sessions of the Commission if it so desires, on conditions similar to those set out in paragraph 10 of the Terms of Reference of the Commission for States Members of the United Nations which are not members of the Commission.
