

# A. INTRODUCTION

The Economic Commission for Africa (ECA) and the Intergovernmental Committee for Migration (ICA) jointly initiated the Return of Skills Programme for Africa whose major objective is to contribute to Africa's economic and social development by helping to redress the shortages of skilled manpower which are afflicting the Continent's development.

A considerable number of Africans with useful qualifications and experience for Africa have left and continue to leave the continent to settle in industrialized countries. If this brain drain is not slowed down, it would be difficult for Africa to attain its socio-economic development objectives.

The Programme endeavours to bring back to Africa, highly qualified Africans living in developed countries. Thus, it allows Africa to benefit from the skills and experience acquired by its cwn nationals in the course of their training or professional practice in industrialized countries.

The Programme encourages return migration by providing to these Africans a set of benefits considered necessary for their smooth reintegration into living and working in Africa.

Hundreds of doctors, engineers, agriculturists, economists, business managers, teachers and other specialists have returned to Africa and been placed in suitable jobs through the Programme and many more have indicated their wish to be assisted in this regard.

The purpose of this publication is to provide a profile of highly qualified African nationals who wish to return to Africa through the Programme to prospective employers in Government, industry and learning institutions in Africa.

A summary is given of each candidate's curriculum vitae under the following headings: profession, nationality, language ability, education, work experience and publications if any. A code number has been assigned to each individual candidate with the occupational category classified by alphabetical order. Prospective employers who may be interested by any of the candidates and who may wish to request more information on them can telex such requests to FCA, quoting the appropriate code number. However, some candidates appearing in this publication may no longer be available when their services are requested. In such instances ECA will, if possible, propose alternative candidates for the consideration of the requesting party.

Please note that the contents of this thrice-yearly publication series will change by deletion (as candidates become unavailable) or by addition (as new applicants join the Programme). Each new issue of this publication is an up-date of the previous one.
