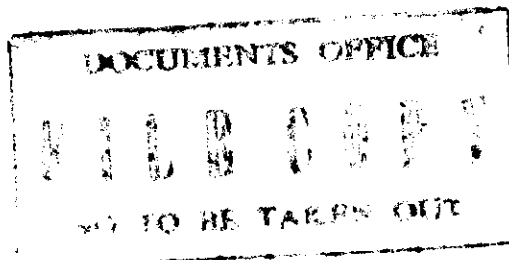

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**ECA ENVIRONMENT IN AFRICA WORK PROGRAMME:
PERFORMANCE REPORT ON CURRENT WORK PROGRAMME AND HARMONIZATION
OF ECA AND UNEP FUTURE WORK PROGRAMME FOR 1986-1987**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. This Environment in Africa Work Programme document consists of the following four parts:

- A. The current work programme for the 1984-1985 biennium;
- B. The Performance Report in implementing the 1984-1985 work programme;
- C. The Environment in Africa Work Programme for the 1986-1987 biennium; and
- D. Harmonization of the ECA Environment in Africa Work Programme with the UNEP Programme for the second biennium of the System-Wide Medium-Term Environment Programme (SWMTEP), both for the 1986-1987 biennium.

2. The current Environment in Africa Work Programme for the 1984-1985 biennium was discussed at the second meeting of the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment (the Joint Committee) held at ECA in January 1984, as an extract from document E/ECA/CM.9/3 which had been considered by the 9th ECA Conference of Ministers held at Addis Ababa in April 1983 before the ECA Work Programme and Priorities for the 1984-1985 biennium was approved by the General Assembly in December 1983.

3. The Performance Report covers only the first year (1984) of the Environment in Africa Work Programme for 1984-1985 biennium. This report as well as the future Environment in Africa Work Programme for the 1986-1987 biennium were considered at the 11th ECA Conference of Ministers held in Addis Ababa 15-27 April 1985 as documents E/ECA/CM.11/55 and E/ECA/CM.11/56 from which they were extracted. The UNEP programme for the second biennium of SWMTEP for the 1986-1987 biennium was approved at the thirteenth session of the UNEP Governing Council held at Gigiri, Nairobi, 13-26 May 1985, including the attached section D above extracted from the document (UNEP/GC.13/8) for implementation in the African region.

4. It is noted that the SWMTEP extract reflects 10 major programming areas in which the environmental aspects of development activities related to energy, transportation, industry, water, oceans, education, law, human settlements, health and so on, are considered for the African region.

5. The Joint Committee is requested to examine the Environment in Africa Work Programme for the 1986-1987 biennium (section C) in conjunction with the harmonization of the UNEP SWMTEP Programme for the African region in section D, and to indicate the interest of countries to participate in the implementation of the various activities recommended for the solution of environmental problems in Africa.

A. Environment in Africa Work Programme for 1984-1985^{1/}

6. This programme is carried out by the Environment Section of the Social Development, Human Settlements and Environment Division. The subprogramme, programme elements, and related output over the biennium are described below:

Subprogramme. Development of environmental capabilities including conservation of resources and pollution control

(a) Resource requirements:

Regular budget: \$212,700 (100 per cent of programme total);

(c) Programme elements:

1.1 Technical co-operation for developing national environmental capabilities

Output:

(i) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on developing guidelines for the establishment or improvement of national institutions to assess, monitor and control environmental degradation in Africa, including the setting up of national standards (first quarter, 1984);

(ii) Substantive servicing of meeting on establishing or improving national standards for the protection of the African environment (third quarter, 1985).

1.2 Co-ordination of environmental activities within ECA and with UNEP

Output:

(i) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on the review of the implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification in the ECA region (second quarter, 1984);

(ii) Substantive servicing of the third meeting of the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on planning environmental policies and priorities of programming activities in Africa (second quarter, 1984).

1.3 Environmental assessment and management relating to the impact of development on natural resources utilization*

Output:

(i) Report to the ECA Conference of Ministers on the state of the environment in Africa with special reference to desertification, deforestation, soil degradation, pollution and conservation of natural resources and energy (first quarter, 1984)

(ii) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on environmental health and sanitation problems in Africa relating to water resources development (fourth quarter, 1985);

(iii) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on the review of national environmental legislation and strategies for law enforcement and accession to international environmental conventions and protocols in the African region (fourth quarter, 1984);

(iv) Report to the Council of Ministers of Multinational Programming and Operational Centres (MULPOC) on a study of environmental problems arising from the exploration of underground water for agricultural use in the Sudano-Sahelian zone of the Niamey-based MULPOC (second quarter, 1985);

(v) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on the methods for establishing environmental profiles and environmental impact statements for development projects in Africa (first quarter, 1985).

1.4 Development of manpower capabilities and creation of environmental awareness through environmental training and education activities

Output:

(i) Report to the Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on developing an action plan in environmental education and training for manpower development and public awareness of environmental problems in Africa based on 1982-1983 programme activities (third quarter, 1984);

(ii) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on the development of environmental training for coastal area management, monitoring of marine pollution and the rate of depletion of marine resources in the exclusive economic zones in the West African regional seas countries (fourth quarter, 1984)

1.5 Pollution control and waste disposal in relation to agricultural and industrial development**

Output:

(i) Report to the Council of Ministers of Multinational Programming and Operational Centres (MULPOC) on case studies of the effects of industrial pollution and waste disposal on human settlements and agricultural practices in the Tangiers-based MULPOC (second quarter, 1985);

(ii) Report to the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment on the environmental impact of industrialization in Africa (first quarter, 1985).

Resource requirements (at revised 1983 rates)

Redeployment of posts

: As indicated in paragraph 13.3 above, one p-4 and one local level post have been transferred from "Executive direction and management".

Consultants

The estimated requirements (\$100) under this heading relate to one work-month of consultancy under programme element 1.1 for the assessment of national capabilities in setting up national standards for environmental protection.

Ad hoc expert group

The estimated requirements under this heading (\$21,300) relate to a meeting which will assist the secretariat in assessing the report of the consultant on the subject referred to in the above paragraph prior to its submission to an intergovernmental meeting.

Other official travel of staff

The estimated requirements under this heading (\$15,000) relate to surveys and consultations with Governments in order to follow up on policy implementation (programme elements 1.1, 1.4 and 1.5).

B. Performance Report for the Environment in Africa Work Programme (1984-1985)^{2/}

Performance

Thirteen outputs were planned for delivery in 1984-1985, and it is expected that all will be implemented. In addition, five additional outputs required by legislation and one at the initiative of the secretariat were also implemented. An implementation rate of 100 per cent is expected by the end of the biennium.

Departures from programmed commitments (additional outputs)

Five additional outputs are expected, as follows:

(i) Substantive servicing of the scientific Round Table on the Climatic Situation and Drought in Africa (Addis Ababa, 20-23 February 1984), in keeping with resolution 473 (XVIII) of the ECA Conference of Ministers;

(ii) Report to the Scientific Round Table on the impacts of and responses to drought on the socio-economic systems in Africa (first quarter, 1984);

(iii) Report to the ECA Conference of Ministers on feasibility studies to establish an advanced centre for meteorology in Africa, as requested by resolution 528 (XIX) on meteorological services for drought in Africa (1985);

(iv) Substantive servicing of the third meeting of the Joint Intergovernmental Regional Committee on Human Settlements and Environment (third quarter, 1985);

(v) Substantive servicing of ECA/UNDRO/OAU Meeting on natural disasters prevention and prediction in Africa (24/25 February 1984) (at the initiative of the secretariat).

C. Environment in Africa Work Programme for 1986-1987^{3/}

Programme objectives

This programme is carried out by the Environment Section of the Social Development, Environment and Human Settlements Division. It has one subprogramme whose objectives during the plan period 1984-1989 will be as follows:

Work programme

SUBPROGRAMME 1: DEVELOPMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CAPABILITIES INCLUDING CONSERVATION OF RESOURCES AND POLLUTION CONTROL

(a) General objectives of the secretariat: To assist member States in the formulation of environmental policies, in the establishment of institutions, including legislative

bodies, and in the design and organization of manpower training with technological support, environmental education for the public, and an information system for controlling environmental problems, and to promote the development and management of land-based, coastal and marine natural resource the use of non-conventional sources of energy, pollution control in the development process and measures to combat the growing encroachment of deserts on arable land.
