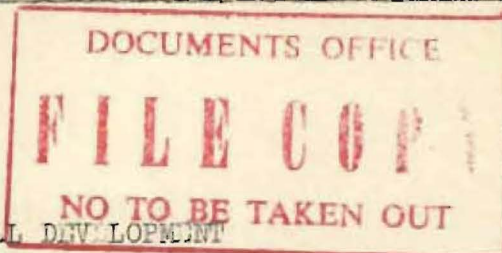

Resolution 26(III) adopted by the Commission at its 47th plenary meeting
on 15 February 1961.

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Recalling paragraphs 1(b), (c), and (g), of its terms of reference,
Conscious of the need to develop human resources in Africa as a
means of promoting rapid economic development in all the territories
of Africa,

1. Requests the Executive Secretary to make sub-regional studies of
the economic and social consequences of racial discriminatory
practices on the mobilisation of all available resources for the
balanced economic development of all territories within the
geographical scope of the Commission and to report back to the
Commission at its fourth session,
2. Appeals to all member governments to facilitate the work of the
Executive Secretary in the implementation of this resolution.
