

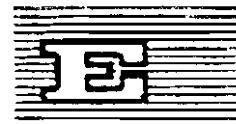

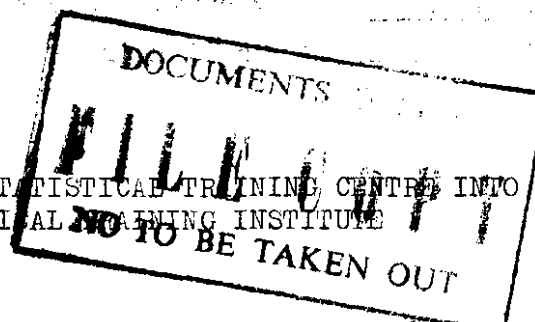

CONVERSION OF THE YAOUNDE STATISTICAL TRAINING CENTRE INTO
AN AFRICAN STATISTICAL TRAINING INSTITUTE



Resolution 146(VII) adopted by the Commission at its 126th plenary
meeting on 22 February 1965

The Economic Commission for Africa,

Recognizing the importance of statistics in the process of
economic and social development,

Being aware of the needs of the African countries in this field,

Noting the growing importance of the Yaounde Centre by reason
of the increase in the number of its students, its African function,
and the geographical range of its instruction,

1. Welcomes the great success of the Centre and the assistance
provided by the United Nations;

2. Requests the Executive Secretary to renew the agreement
governing the Centre between the United Nations and the Federal
Republic of Cameroon;

3. Requests the Executive Secretary to make representations
to the appropriate organizations with a view to one or more
permanent teachers being made available to the Centre;

4. Requests the Executive Secretary to study the question of
converting the Centre into an international statistical training ins-
titute open to all Africans and operating under the auspices of the
United Nations and the host country, and to report to the Commission
at the eighth session;

5. Invites the Executive Secretary to propose technical and financial methods of contributing to the development of the institute.
