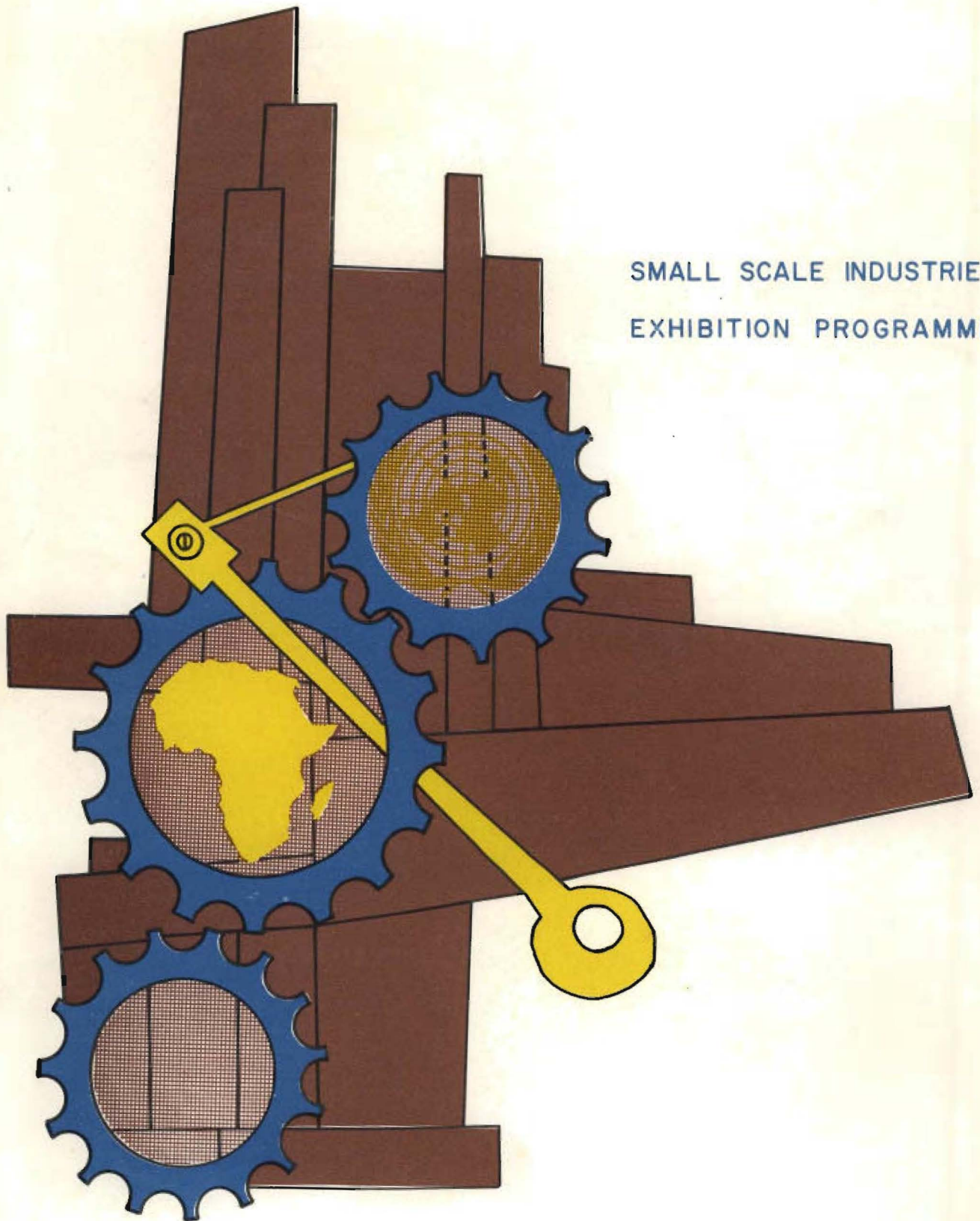

The Exhibition on Small-Scale Industries has been organized as one of the major events in the celebration of the Tenth Anniversary of the establishment of the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa.

It is intended, by the Exhibition, to focus attention on the importance and significance of small-scale industries to the economies of African countries; to show examples of what individual African and other countries, with low investment costs, have achieved in the development and promotion of small-scale industrial enterprises; and, thereby, to encourage and enthuse African entrepreneurship.

Nineteen countries are participating in the Exhibition and the wares on display in their respective pavilions include:

- products made by small-scale industries in Africa and elsewhere, e.g., household utensils and appliances; stationery and other educational materials; articles of clothing; and arts and crafts;
- machinery used in small-scale industries which could be manufactured in Africa, e.g., simple hand tools; agricultural implements; mechanical and electrical appliances; and parts of any such machinery; and
- literature on or demonstration of such products and machinery.

His Imperial Majesty Haile Selassie I, Emperor of Ethiopia, has graciously consented to open the Exhibition.

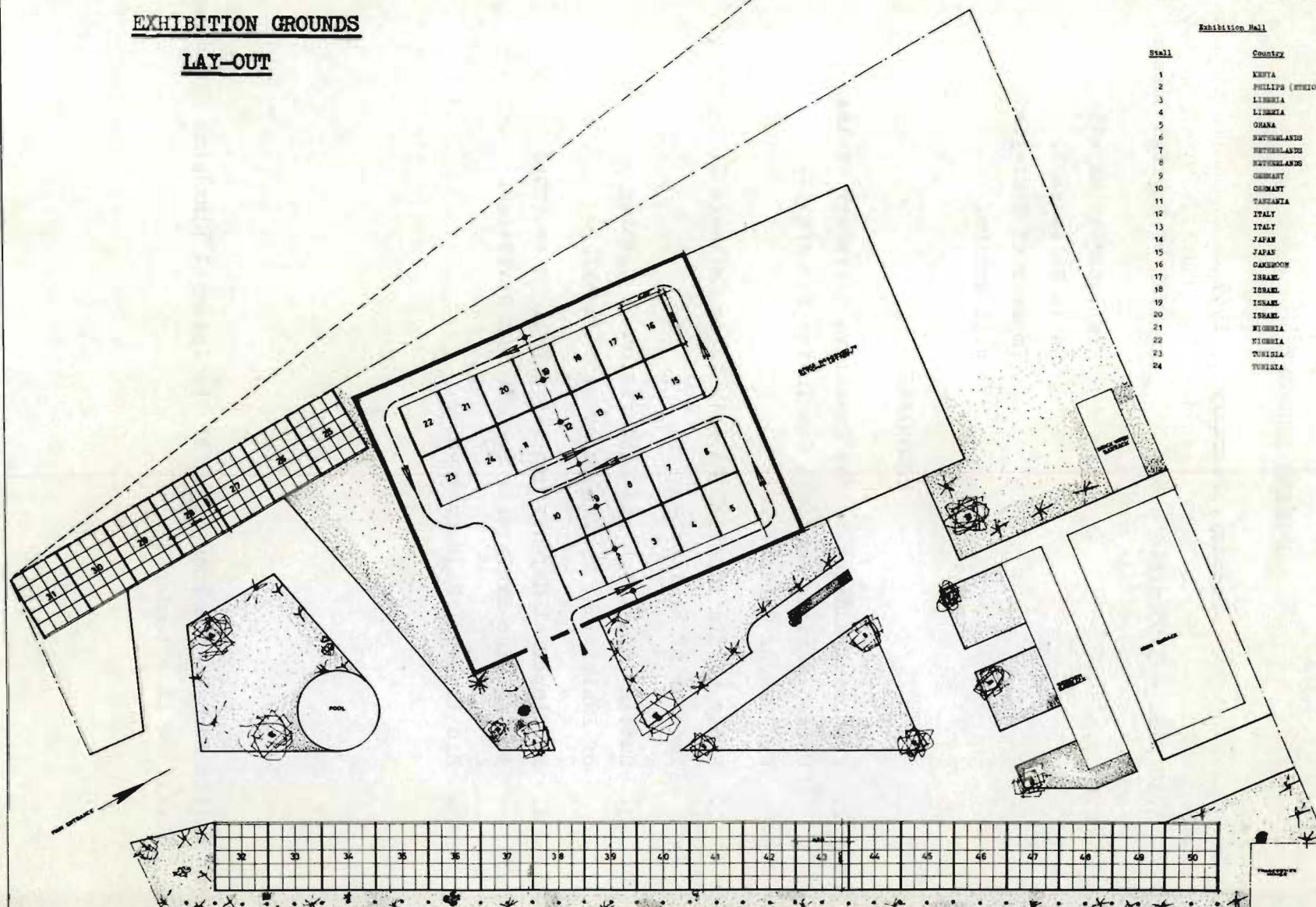
