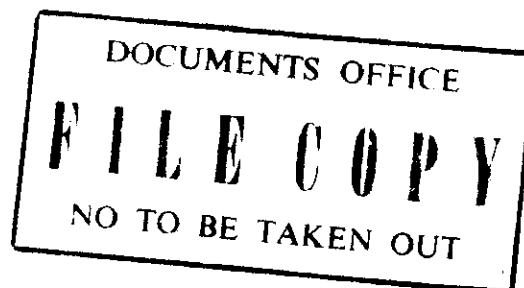

Corrigendum
